Career Center Award: Behavioral Health Network

Behavioral Health Network was honored for its partnership with GCC to pilot a paid Behavioral Health Associate training model. By compensating participants for their training time, BHN addressed key barriers to recruitment and retention in the behavioral health field, resulting in stronger job placements and higher retention. Their leadership has inspired other employers to adopt this innovative approach, strengthening the regional workforce.
