The 4-week **Foundational Manufacturing** training is held Monday - Thursday (and some Fridays), 4:00-9:15 pm for 20 hrs/week in Greenfield, plus online trainings.

- Introduction to Lean Manufacturing

Already in the manufacturing field? Ready to advance? Want to learn a new skilled trade?

Local manufacturers are hiring!

The 8-week **Computer Numerical Control (CNC) Operator** trainings is held Monday - Thursday (and some Fridays), 4:00-9:15 pm for 20 hrs/week in class at the Franklin County Technical School, plus online trainings.

Classes include:

- Blueprint Reading II
- CNC Programming
- Introduction to CAD
- CNC Career Readiness
- Manual Mill & Lathe
- CNC Mill Operations
- CNC Lathe Operations

Trainings will prepare you for an entry level position as a machinist:

- Starting wages range from \$15/hr to \$23/hr.
- Take more advanced courses toward a 1-year certificate or an associates degree with an Engineering Technology focus
- Experienced precision machinists can make \$40,000 to \$75,000 annually

Programs are offered through a partnership between GCC, Franklin County Technical School, the MassHire Franklin-Hampshire Workforce Board and Career Centers, area manufacturing companies and community partners to meet the growing need for skilled workers in manufacturing.

Funding is available for eligible participants.
